Fauré himself described his Requiem as "a lullaby of death," and it was almost certainly inspired by the death of his parents in the 1880s. Unlike many of his contemporaries, Fauré had no clear religious beliefs and thus, in place of the sombre nature of many requiems that had gone before, Fauré's is noted for its calm, serenity and peace.
