Specifically we would like to discuss:


1. Existing and future plans to improve water infrastructure across Surrey.

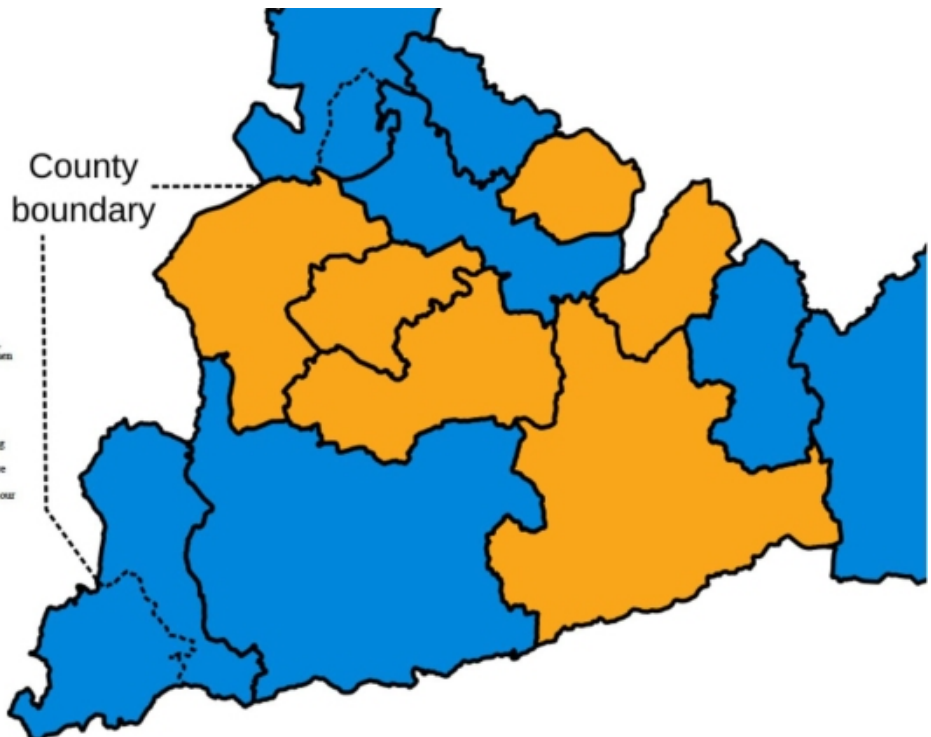
